- 5. Is it God's or your responsibility to be humble?
- 6. How can our actions be good, but our heart be bad?
- 7. What are some things that can cause us to be prideful in mobilizing others?
- 8. How do we balance the call to be humble, but also be bold in calling people to God's mission?

Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-20.

- 9. A core value of the mobilization ministry that produced this resource is "own the whole, and play your part." How do these verses and this ministry value speak to the role of mobilization within the Body of Christ?
- 10. What dangers are there in only focusing on missions and mobilization in your church, and disregarding all the other ministries or service opportunities?

- 12. Is there anyone that you need to go ask repentance from that you have been prideful towards with your thoughts or actions?
